Multi-site Randomized Clinical Trial of FIT Teens for Juvenile Fibromyalgia

This multi-site randomized trial will test whether a new intervention combining cognitive-behavioral strategies with neuromuscular exercise (Fibromyalgia Integrative Training for Teens - FIT Teens) leads to reductions in disability and pain in adolescents with juvenile fibromyalgia. The study is a 3-arm trial comparing FIT Teens with cognitive-behavioral therapy (CBT) alone and graded aerobic exercise (GAE) alone.

20 years ago I was recruited out of fellowship to the Cincinnati Children's Hospital Medical Center to formalize pain management services. The first years were marked by a flurry of activity both clinically and in development of clinical programs and in establishing pain management research. I did this with my main collaborator, Dr. Susmita Kashikar-Zuck of the Division of Psychology. Our clinical and research programs were among the earlier interdisciplinary programs in our institution. Since that time, I have led the development a one of the largest and most comprehensive Pediatric Pain and Palliative Care programs in the world. It is not an understatement that our programs are world-renowned. As an example, we currently have a visitor from Brazil who has come to see how our programs operate, so she can try to establish something similar in her home city. While building our programs over the years, I have enjoyed tremendous academic productivity as well as the satisfaction of establishing interdisciplinary pain care programs throughout our institution. In addition to the main Pain Clinic, we see patients in the Epidermolysis Bullosa Clinic, the Pancreas Care Center, Sickle Cell Clinic, inpatient PM&R floor, participated in the Hemangioma and Vascular Malformation Center and are currently exploring a possible collaboration with Genetics for the care of patients with Ehlers-Danlos Syndrome. My academic activities have featured collaborative relations across multiple divisions and departments and outside institutions. The terms “interdisciplinary” and “collaboration” would be two of the most consistent words used to describe my overall professional career. When I was promoted to Professor, it had been 14 years since the last such promotion in our department, and I am proud to have played a leadership role in academic productivity.

On a national level, I have participated in a number of professional societies in leadership and collaborative capacities that has advanced our field. I am currently one of the founding members of a

national interdisciplinary work group whose goal is to establish novel training fellowships for pediatricians which do not currently exist, but would satisfy a tremendous clinical need for pain practitioners. Planning for the future of our field and finding sustainable ways to meet the needs of patients across the country has become a focus of my time and energies.

Within the current educational structure, we established the second ACGME-accredited pediatric pain fellowship in the United States. The fellowship has provided me many opportunities to form mentoring relationships with fellows. I did not list all of our graduates (*vida supra*), as I consider the mentor role to be unique and beyond simply being a teaching attending. We have graduated multiple ABA and ABPMR board eligible pain physicians who have taken both team and leadership positions across the country. I established pain management as a formal components of the pediatric residency didactic program and we are active participants on multiple levels with the education of faculty and staff in the medical center. I currently chair the pain management steering committee for the hospital which oversees all things related to pain management on administrative educational and advocacy level.
